## ***National Parks Adventure* Premieres in IMAX at the Fort Worth Museum of Science and History's Omni Theater**

**Fort Worth, TX** – Imagine soaring over red rock canyons, up craggy mountain peaks, and into other-worldly realms found within the nation. Envision hiking, climbing, and exploring America's majestic parks next to world-class mountaineer Conrad Anker, photographer Max Lowe, and artist Rachel Pohl.

As the National Park Service celebrates its Centennial in 2016, experience the splendor of these natural treasures in the immersive IMAX® cinematography presentation of *National Parks Adventure* premiering Friday, February 12<sup>th</sup> at the Fort Worth Museum of Science and History's Omni Theater IMAX Dome.

*National Parks Adventure* is an action-packed road trip that inspires the adventurer in us all, and highlights the importance of preservation.

A MacGillivray Freeman film, *National Parks Adventure* is narrated by Academy Award winning Robert Redford and is produced in association with *Brand USA* and presented globally by *Expedia, Inc.* and *Subaru of America, Inc.* *REI* is the domestic sponsor of the film. The Omni Theater was the first IMAX screen in the Southwest and, with an eight-story domed screen and 30-degree stadium seating, remains the largest IMAX dome in the United States west of the Mississippi River. The Omni's 120-foot-wide screen places the audience in the center of the action, producing a sensation much closer to real-life than a conventional movie theater.
