

# Chaperone Support Guide

Thank you for taking time out of your busy schedule to visit the Fort Worth Museum of Science and History. Your role is crucial in your children's educational experience and safety.

We realize you are responsible for a group of children while they are on their field trip.

## Here are a few tips to make your day successful:

- All children must be accompanied by an adult chaperone at all times.
- Restrooms are located in Stars Café, upstairs before you enter the Special Exhibitions Gallery and in the Link area near the OMNI Theater. All restrooms are handicap accessible.
- In case of an emergency or lost child, contact the nearest staff person.
- Food and drinks are not permitted in the exhibit areas.
- In the event of severe weather, please follow staff instructions.
- Running, shouting, or spitting will turn our smiles into serious frowns.
- Please note: Two Museum areas feature activities for specific age groups. Innovation Studio activities are designed for children 3rd grade and older. The Fort Worth Children's Museum welcomes children 2nd grade and younger only. If needed, divide your children into these age groups before entering the Museum.

## Please remember:

- The Museum does not have a storage area for sack lunches or coolers. Please check with your Leader to arrange a common time and place for your group to meet for lunch.
- Your group is welcome to picnic on any of the exterior grassy areas adjacent to the Museum and the exterior Stars Café Terrace. These areas are available daily on a first come, first serve basis.
- In the event of inclement weather, the Museum will attempt to accommodate your group's lunch inside the Museum. Upon arrival the Leader will sign up for a time and place for your group to have lunch. Please be sure to check with the Leader to find out your assigned time and place for lunch.
- We invite you to visit Stars Café or Reel Refreshments and Shop Too!
- Our staff is here to support you. If you have any other questions or concerns, do not hesitate to ask for assistance.
